

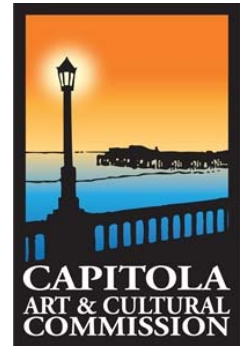

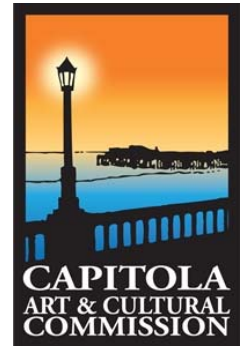

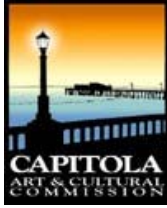

Recommended Action: Receive report from committees or staff.

BACKGROUND

The Capitola Art & Cultural Commission is an advisory body whose responsibility is to advise the City Council as to the allocation of public art funds and encouragement of existing and new programs in the arts for the enjoyment of the residents.

The Art & Cultural Commission participates in annual goal setting from which cultural programs in the arts are planned for the budget year with City Council approval. The 2024/25 budget has planned twelve (12) Twilight Concerts, four (4) Art at the Beach, two (2) Movies at the Beach and Plein Air. Staff provide program reports on activity when relevant.

The Commission forms Committees for the support of City programs and shall report to the Commission no less than quarterly under the Bylaws. Committees shall consist of no fewer than two (2) and no more than three (3) commissioners. If a vacancy occurs, the commission can choose to appoint a commissioner to the vacancy. The committees are as follows:

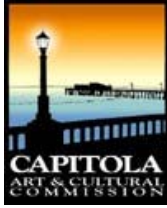
- 1) Twilight Concerts: Vice Chair Johnson, Commissioner Lengre, Commissioner Sylvan and Public Member James Wallace, sit on the committee.
- 2) Volunteer Recruitment: Chair Cahalen, Council Member Clarke sit on the committee.
- 3) Plein Air: Commissioner Anderson, Commissioner Lengre, Chair Cahalen sit on the committee.
- 4) Makers Market (Formerly Art at the Beach): Commissioner Holmberg, Commissioner Lengre, Commissioner Christinsen sit on the committee.
- 5) Weekend Music: Chair Cahalen, Commissioner Anderson, Commissioner Christinsen sit on the committee.

DISCUSSION

Regular reports from staff and committees are provided to enhance communication and planning as well as keeping the entire commission up to date on the progress made by staff or committees. Program Reports are intended to only report out on progress. Any action requiring the entire commission to make a decision will be added to a future agenda under General Business.

Recommended Action:

Review Commissioner applications and recommend appointment to City Council for vacant At-Large commission seat.

BACKGROUND

The Capitola Municipal Code requires that the commissioners be appointed by the City Council upon recommendation by the Art & Cultural Commission and shall serve a two-year term. In September 2019 City Council updated the Bylaws and removed term limits for Commissioners on the Art and Cultural Commission. According to the Bylaws, members do not need to be Capitola residents.

The Art & Cultural Commission consists of nine members. There are eight (8) commissioners currently serving whose term expires on December 31, 2025, and there is one open seat for an At-Large designation.

The City Clerk's office has opened an application period for any interested parties to serve on the city Board or Commissions for City Council appointments to be conducted at the April 24, 2025, City Council Meeting.

DISCUSSION

The City Clerk has received five (5) new applications for Art & Cultural Commissioner and has six (6) on file from the recruitment in Fall 2024. As part of the application process any prospective commissioner must attend an Art & Cultural Commission meeting and conference with the commission regarding the duties and responsibilities of being an Art & Cultural Commissioner to receive a recommendation for City Council to appoint.

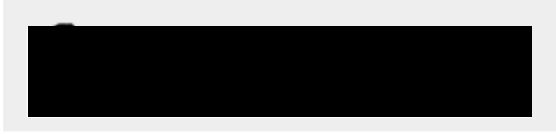

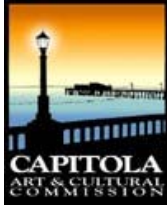
