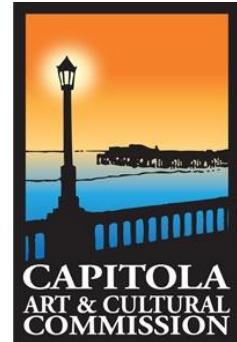

c. Rispin Reflecting Pool Public Art

Report given by Staff. Commissioner Sylvan clarified grant restrictions. Commissioner Holmberg suggested the pool configuration with a center drain and graduated slope of $\frac{1}{4}$ in per foot toward the drain and preference for a water feature. Mayor Clarke commented the Call should focus on just the pool and commission consider other projects in the Park once complete. Commissioner Christensen commented on a fountain option. The Commission agreed to use existing park lighting and modify Call to Artist to reflected suggested changes. Staff to check on status of grant and add a “Future Site of Public Art” sign to the pool.
