SUBJECT: Esplanade Park Sculpture

Recommended Action: Receive Report

BACKGROUND; The Esplanade Park playable sculpture selection committee issued a call to artists using the online CaFE system. The initial call to artists closed on July 24, 2017. There were over 45 submissions for the sculpture. The selection committee reviewed the submissions and selected three artists to submit proposals; Ed Kroupa, Evelyn Davis/Sean Monaghan and Kim Chavez.

The plan is to have the three selected artists to present their proposals at the November 14, 2017 Commission Meeting.

Staff will take the recommendation of the Commission to the City Council for consideration.

Recommended Action: Receive Report

BACKGROUND: At the May 9 meeting, the Commission recommended that the railing design by Ernest and Lois Rich be brought to the City Council for approval. Staff has informed both the finalists of the Commission's recommendation. Staff informed the Rich's that the area will be looked at as park of the City's ADA transition plan after July 1 to verify the accessibility of the location.

SUBJECT: Commissioner Recruitment

Recommended Action: Receive Report

BACKGROUND: The Art and Cultural Commission has nine seats. Currently the Art and Cultural Commission has eight members, the Arts Professional Commissioner seat has been vacant since January 1, 2017. Five of the current commissioners have terms that expire at the end of 2017. Vice-Chair Cross will not be eligible to re-apply due to term limitations. The four other commissioners can re-apply for their existing seats.

The City will continue recruitment for the Arts Professional seat and begin recruitment expiring seats. Previously termed-out Commissioners who have not served on Commission for the most recent twoyears are eligible to re-apply.

FISCAL IMPACT; There is no anticipated fiscal impact
