Are you interested in finance and how local government is funded? The City of Capitola's Finance Advisory Committee is seeking youth member(s).

The Finance Advisory Committee provides advice and recommendations to the City Council about the financial policy of the City of Capitola, including the City's budget, investments, revenue projections and assumptions, and revenue enhancement programs.

Youth members need to be accompanied by an adult and either reside within the Soquel Union Elementary School District or attend Soquel, Harbor or Aptos High School. These are non-voting positions that provide experience serving on a government-appointed board. The term runs through August, and selected youth may reapply for another term.

Finance Advisory Committee meetings are held on the third Tuesday of every other month at 6 p.m. in the Community Room at City Hall. Special meetings may be scheduled as needed.
