City Proposes a Transaction and Use ("Sales") Tax Measure

CAPITOLA — The Capitola City Council voted on July 28, 2016, to place a measure on the November ballot to extend the sunset date on an existing one quarter cent (0.25%) Measure D sales tax. At the same hearing the City Council indicated that uses from the Measure should go toward protecting the wharf and beach from storms and rising sea levels, maintaining the Police Department at full staffing and improving parks, sidewalks and bike lanes. It is anticipated the Measure would generate about \$1 million annually in General Fund revenues.

A recently commissioned independent survey of Capitola residents shows as much as 81 percent would support a 10-year extension of the sales tax. To pass, the measure will require approval from 50% of those who cast votes.

The following ballot measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Capitola at the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016:
