4. PUBLIC HEARINGS

NOTE: Any person seeking to challenge a City Council decision made as a result of a proceeding in which, by law, a hearing is required to be given, evidence is required to be taken, and the discretion in the determination of facts is vested in the City Council, shall be required to commence that court action within ninety (90) days following the date on which the decision becomes final as provided in Code of Civil Procedure §1094.6. Please refer to code of Civil Procedure §1094.6 to determine how to calculate when a decision becomes "final." Please be advised that in most instances the decision become "final" upon the City Council's announcement of its decision at the completion of the public hearing. Failure to comply with this 90-day rule will preclude any person from challenging the City Council decision in court.

Continued Public Hearing on Application #10-008 to Consider Proposed Changes to Title 17 of the Capitola Municipal Code related to the Parking Requirements and Allowed Uses in the CC (Community Commercial) Zoning District, and the Addition of Definitions for "Floor Area Available for Dining" and "Restaurant." If approved, the Proposed Changes require an Amendment to the City's Certified Local Coastal Plan, which must be reviewed by the California Coastal Commission.
