## CAPITOLA CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2014

#### 7. CITY COUNCIL / CITY TREASURER / STAFF COMMENTS

Council Member Harlan stated that the Capitola Book Café is closing.

Council Member Bottorff stated that the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) is releasing the Metropolitan Transportation Plan and the Sustainable Communities Strategies (Plan) for a 55-day public comment period. He stated that the public can attend the following AMBAG workshops regarding the Plan: March 4, 2014, in Watsonville; and Thursday March 6, 2014, in Santa Cruz.

Council Member Termini provided an update from a recent Santa Cruz County Library Joint Powers Board meeting. He requested that staff address prohibiting the sale of tobacco products near public libraries.

Council Member Storey stated that the Capitola-Soquel Chamber of Commerce and the City will provide a presentation on February 26, 2014, regarding economic issue in a changing retail environment;

#### ACTION

Motion made by Council Member Termini, seconded by Council Member Bottorff, to approve the appointment of Council Member Termini and Council Member Norton, Barbara Gorson, Gayle Ortiz, Lisa Steingrube, and Dave Kraemer to the Library Ad Hoc Committee; and to continue advertising for an appointment for one additional member to this Committee. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Consider a nomination to the Santa Cruz County Hazardous Materials Advisory Commission. [430-50]

#### ACTION

Motion made by Council Member Norton, seconded by Council Member Harlan, to approve nominating Public Works Director Jesberg to be the City's representative on the Santa Cruz County Hazardous Materials Advisory Commission; and to continue advertising for a member from the public to be a representative to this Commission. The motion carried unanimously.

C. Receive the Mayor's appointment(s) to the Architectural and Site Review Committee. [740-15]

Mayor Storey appointed Craig Waltz to serve on the City's Architectural and Site Review Committee.

ACTION Motion made by Council Member Termini seconded by Council Member Harlan, to approve the first reading of the Ordinance the following Consent Calendar items: 9.A.; 9.B.; 9.C.; 9.E.; and 9.F. The motion was passed unanimously.

#### 10. GENERAL GOVERNMENT / PUBLIC HEARINGS

A. Presentation by Kim Adamson, Soquel Creek Water District General Manager, regarding local water issues. [1160-10]

Kim Adamson, Soquel Creek Water District (District), discussed issues related to groundwater aquifer recharge and seawater intrusion, and stated that the District is actively working on reducing water use within the City's service area.

Bruce Daniels, Soquel Creek Water District Board Vice President, spoke about climate.

B. Consider an Ordinance amending Section 10.04.010 and adding Section 10.32.030 to the Capitola Municipal Code pertaining to Vehicles and Traffic [1st Reading]. [490-20]

ACTION Motion made by Council Member Norton, seconded by Council Member Termini, to approve the first reading of the Ordinance amending Section 10.04.010 and adding Section 10.32.030 to the Capitola Municipal Code pertaining to Vehicles and Traffic. The motion was passed unanimously.

C. Consider McGregor Park Sponsorship Program. [1040-20]

ACTION Motion made by Council Member Norton, seconded by Council Member Termini, to approve the McGregor Park Donation and Sponsorship Program; and that the maintenance sponsorship for the Dog Park be raised to \$2,000 annually. The motion was passed unanimously.

D. Consider a Resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Capitola Fee Schedule to incorporate the 2013-2014 Animal Services Authority Fee Schedule, Green Energy Incentive fees, and Village Sidewalk Signs fees. [390-40]

ACTION Motion made by Council Member Harlan, seconded by Council Member Norton, to adopt <u>Resolution No. 3979</u> amending the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Capitola Fee Schedule to incorporate the 2013-2014 Animal Services Authority Fee Schedule, Green Energy Incentive fees, and Village Sidewalk Signs fees. The motion was passed unanimously.

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E. Consider a Resolution allowing the City of Capitola to accept ownership of quit claims of two small parcels pending approval from the Successor Agency, Oversight Board, and the California Department of Finance. [810-10/780-60]

**ACTION** 

Motion made by Council Member Harlan, seconded by Council Member Bottorff, to adopt <u>Resolution No. 3980</u> allowing the City of Capitola to accept ownership of quit claims of two small parcels pending approval from the Successor Agency, Oversight Board, and the California Department of Finance. The motion was passed unanimously.

Council Member Norton requested that staff to prepare operational guidelines for the Lower Pacific Cove Parking Lot for City Council consideration prior to completion of the project.

Motion made by Council Member Norton, seconded by Council Member Bottorff, to adopt <u>Ordinance No. 992</u> amending Chapter 10.36.055 of the Capitola Municipal Code amending parking meter Zone B [2nd Reading]; and to adopt a <u>Resolution No. 3977</u> authorizing submittal of amendments to the Local Coastal Program to the Coastal Commission. The motion was passed unanimously.
