At its June 14 regular meeting, the City Council will consider approving a special event permit for the Capitola Beach Festival on Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 29-30, 2018. Activities include a race of up to 5,000 participants with related road closures on Opal Cliff and Cliff Drive and in Capitola Village 6:30 -10:30 a.m. on Saturday and a lighted float parade that evening on Soquel Creek with closure of the Stockton Avenue Bridge 6:30-9 p.m. The event would also include many of the same activities as the former Begonia Festival, including horseshoe and sandcastle contests, a fishing derby, and rowboat races.
