- ✓ Vacation House Checks checking residents' homes while they are out of town.
- ✓ Court Liaison transporting documents between the Police Department and other government facilities.
- Clerical Work assisting with data entry, filing, and general paperwork.
- ✓ Senior Citizen Welfare Checks ensuring that seniors are doing well in their homes.
- ✓ Community Outreach Center staffing the Capitola Mall Outreach Center (CORC).
- ✓ Community Policing helping identify and address specific concerns and problems within the community.

## CHOOSING OUR VOLUNTEERS

Here is how it works:

- APPLY in person at the Police
   Department, Monday Friday, 8:00 am –
   5:00 pm; have us mail you an application; or apply online. This is the first step in becoming a VIP.
- INTERVIEW your eligibility will be determined by the Capitola Police Department VIP Committee and an inperson interview.
- BACKGROUND CHECK is the final step in the process. Due to the nature of police services, these checks are comprehensive.
