

Capitola – Soquel Creek (Capitola Village, Riverview Drive, Riverview Ave)

EVACUATION ORDER: EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY 1/4/2023

The Capitola Police Department has issued an evacuation order for this area. Please evacuate immediately and move to higher ground.

Heavy rains, wind, and runoff have prompted evacuation orders for parts of Santa Cruz County, including portions of Capitola Village. Soquel Creek levels are rising rapidly due to intense rainfall and runoff. There is a high probability of flooding to occur in the low-lying residences in lower Riverview and Capitola Village tonight – Map attached.

Remaining in this evacuated area could cause a risk to personal safety and limit the ability of medical or rescue personnel to get to you.

CAPITOLA: Addresses impacted under this Evacuation Order are attached to this map. All other areas within CTL-E028 and CTL-E029 are under an <u>Evacuation Warning</u>.
