


# Hill Street Bicycle & Pedestrian IMPROVEMENT OPTIONS SESSION



**FEBRUARY 16<sup>th</sup> | 6:30 PM | 420 Capitola Ave**

Hello Neighbors,

The City of Capitola Public Works will be holding a session on **February 16th, from 6:30-8pm at 420 Capitola Ave** to discuss alternatives to improve pedestrian and bicycle use along Hill Street, specifically on the stretch between Capitola Avenue and Rosedale Avenue. Currently, parking is allowed on both sides of the street and there is no continuous sidewalk or dedicated bike lanes on either side of the street.



## Alternative 1

Remove parking on south side and install a Class II bike lane on the south side. Maintain parking on the north side and stripe a Class III bike lane on the north side. No sidewalk will be constructed.

## Alternative 2

Maintain parking on south side and stripe Class III bike lanes and construct a 5' sidewalk on the south side. Remove parking on the north side. A sidewalk could be constructed on the south side when funds are available.

## Alternative 3

Remove parking on the south side and construct a 5' sidewalk on both sides. Maintain parking on north side. Bike lanes will not be installed.

The project also includes the construction of a sidewalk on the east side of Capitola Avenue, just north of Hill Street. This gap closure will provide a continuous connection for pedestrians southward, towards the Village and the beach.
