

Project Background



- Project purpose and goals:
 - 1. Full road surface reconstruction
 - 2. Enhance pedestrian and bicycle access with new crossings, signs, and striping
 - 3. Provide visibility improvements at Wharf / Clares intersection
 - 4. Minimize construction timing delays to existing residents
- Project funded by Measure D, SB1, and Santa Cruz County RTIP

Proposed Road Repair




- ■Cold in place recycling (CIR) this treatment treats the existing asphalt as an asset.
 - Cost effective restore and reuse the existing material
 - Efficient reducing the amount of material to be hauled off/to the site
 - Quick cars back on the street the same day the paving process

Bicycle Features




- Existing Class II bike lanes would be restriped
- Repaved roadway would improve bicycle experience and access along Clares Street
- Addition of buffered bike lanes
- Addition of green bike lanes




Pedestrian Safety Features

- Improve pedestrian visibility to approaching vehicles
- Advance pedestrian crossing signs with RRFB lights

Pedestrian Safety Features – Curb Bulb Out





































On-Street Parking




- ■There are approximately 75 on-street parking spaces along Clares
- Raised crosswalks or curb bulb outs would result in the loss of approximately 8 on-street parking spaces



Option 1 - Standard Striping








